## ***President's Report***

As I end my fourth term as your president I must thank you the membership for allowing me to represent such a great group of people who take pride in their Germanic heritage. Your continued support strengthens my belief in this club and pushes me to do as much as I can do to ensure the longevity of the Concordia Club. I look forward to strengthening our personal relationships and promise to continue to build a solid financial foundation for our club so that you, the members, can enjoy coming to a place where you are able to enjoy the company of fellow members who are proud of the German language, culture, heritage and traditions.

The outcome of the election is not known at the time of this report being written but we will once again have a full board. I would like to thank Mike Brasch for his 17 years of service as a member of the board of directors. Mike has been involved in many different positions on the board and has been the float liaison for the Concordia club for many

years. His knowledge and open minded approach will be missed and we know that he is only a phone call away. The second person that I would like to thank is Rolf Malthaner. Rolf has decided to channel his energies in a different direction after 4 years on the board and we wish him well in his future endeavours. He has left some big shoes to fill as Rolf was the Oktoberfest Chairperson for the board for the past 4 years and this followed a few years of tutelage under his father, Hans Malthaner.

Looking forward to 2018 we have set a low budget as we are not 100 % sure on how the minimum wage increase is going to affect the club. In any business your wages are your biggest controllable expense so we will continue to monitor this to ensure it does not have a negative effect on the year end numbers to an extent greater than what we thought. With the help of the 2, 5 and 10 year capital plans we will complete any needed replacements or job tasks that have been identified within these aforementioned plans.

The Concordia club has enjoyed 144 years of prosperity in Kitchener and we must

keep the vision of our founding fathers alive. I therefore challenge all members to take pride in where we came from, what we have and where we can go to. This pride will develop into a passion, and with these 2 items working together we will be able to enjoy the longevity that we have, for many more years to come. The second piece to the puzzle will be our ability to diversify. We must be attractive to a diverse group of people as Kitchener/Waterloo has become a very ethnically diverse area of the province due to the transition of manufacturing jobs to the ever popular tech sector that we are today. We must also have the diversity to change within the club to welcome all those who wish to join our organization.

This winter has been a real roller coaster as we started with a very cold snap in December, followed by weather that one day

allowed you to wear short sleeves and the next to be bundled up in your parka. Keep those thoughts of the warm spring nights near as we will hopefully see the beauty of spring colours within the next 6 weeks.
