

PRESIDENTS REPORT


As I sit and write this report the weather is just starting to change from the very cool and wet spring that we are not accustomed to, to some very anticipated dry and warmer weather.



Aurora and this year's members: Tequila and Carling! More pictures to follow in the next issue!





PRESIDENT'S MID-YEAR REPORT

The Club started 2025 with some very slow sales for the first few weeks but once we got the ball rolling, we kept gaining momentum. We have continued to grow our membership and business as the year has progressed.

The first event for 2025 was Kameradschaftsabend that was hosted by the Transylvania Club at the Alpine Club. Our hosts provided a tasty meal, some great entertainment and a night of camaraderie. We were also able to share a night of dancing and conversing with our fellow German club members.

The board then met to set the budget for this year. To make sure that we had the proper information to do this, we needed to look at all aspects. We looked at the facility, the farm, our rental properties as well as conversing with our groups. Taking all factors into consideration we set a very realistic budget. We have kept the spending to a minimum for this year again as we are in a very tight financial position due to our large capital expenditures over the last 2 years. We will embark on some projects to help the daily function of the Club as well as some areas that will enhance the appearance of the Concordia Club.

The next event was the Annual General Meeting at the end of February. As I have stated in prior bulletin reports, I am a little bit disappointed in the lack of members that are attending these events. We had less than 100 members show up from a base of nearly 800. Please plan on attending the membership meetings as this is your time to find out what is going on at your Club as well as a time for offering your suggestions or opinions. We said good-bye to Rob Krauskopf, a long-time board member and all- around handy man. In saying goodbye to one board member we needed to welcome another, and this person was Heiko Walder.

The President's Ball was a night for us to dress up in our Sunday bests and celebrate the board. The Starry night theme was a testament to our Club and the membership who remain constant as well as the everlasting friendships that many club members make during their time here. The kitchen staff once again offered their mouthwatering cuisine for all to enjoy and they did not disappoint. The rest of the evening was spent enjoying some good conversation, drink and dancing the night away.

At the beginning of April, we were able to resurrect Bockbierfest, after a 5 year hiatus. On this night we said good bye to Stephanie Richtaritsch who represented the Club for the past 2 years with grace and professionalism. The Good Friday curbside pickup fish fry was once again a smashing success as we kept the extended time frame and we sold just shy of 1200 pieces of fish along with a few other dishes.

This was followed by the Easter and Mother's Day buffets. Both time slots for these events were sell outs and the food was outstanding once again.

Club clean-up was the most well attended (yes, the attendance was higher than 2024) and the eager group of volunteers were able to accomplish much more than we expected, as we were almost able to make it all the way around the Club (we will get there next year, I know that I said this last year). Farm clean-up also had an outstanding turnout (over 60 attendees) and this allowed us to use a little elbow grease and polish our diamond in the rough to give it a little more gleam.

The choir entertained a full hall of guests with their spring concert followed by a reception and a new spring concert menu. MANAGER'S MID-YEAR REPORT

The outlook for 2025 is currently positive, and if current trends continue, we are on track to exceed last year's net income. Of course, this will depend on the overall economic climate, which remains uncertain.

Modest increases to our menu prices have helped offset rising food and beverage costs, and we continue to monitor this situation closely. Minimum wage is set to increase by an additional 2% on October 1, following a 4% increase earlier in 2024. This will have a direct impact on our overall wage expenses, including those associated with Oktoberfest. As a result, further price adjustments may be necessary.

While the septic system project has been completed, we now turn our attention to other important infrastructure repairs and maintenance that need to be addressed in the coming months. On the list of repairs is the kitchen floor and steam table. We are also looking at replacing the exterior doors of the building.

Our wedding bookings are down from previous years, but we have managed to book quite a few other events. We have already secured some bookings for 2026 and 2027. Company Christmas parties are making a trend again. We have almost all Friday and Saturdays booked in the Hall. Also, many bookings for the Schenke, have been secured as well!

We welcome back all our regular Oktoberfest bookings throughout our tent and building. This year with the increased interest in our Bus Tours, we have added another day. We will now offer Bus Tours on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, all of which have already been filled. We will be renting out the tent out for Ginger Goat Fest, again this year. This event will take place on Saturday Oct 4th.

I am excited about our upcoming patio season, and hope the weather cooperates. I hope I will get a chance to see many of you throughout the Summer!


