The time for the start of the parade is the same as last year. It is starting at 9:30 instead of 8:30, which may help us get a few more volunteers who might not be early risers. Last year's participants were full of energy and it would be great to have more support and enthusiasm. We will need representatives of the groups, dance groups and the membership to show how much pride we have in our beloved club. #### **Pumpkin Gingerbread**

Wonderfully flavorful and fragrant bread for the holidays.

Prep Time: approx. 15 Minutes. Cook Time: approx. 45 Minutes.

Ready in: approx. 1 hour.

Makes 2 - 9x5 inch loaves (24 servings).

- · 3 cups sugar
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 4 eggs
- 2/3 cup water
- 1 (15 ounce) can pumpkin puree
- 2 teaspoons ground ginger
- 1 teaspoon ground allspice
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground cloves
- 3 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 11/2 teaspoons salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder

#### Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- 2. Lightly grease two 9x5 inch loaf pans.
- In a large mixing, combine sugar, oil and eggs; beat until smooth. Add water and beat until well blended. Stir in pumpkin, ginger, allspice and cinnamon.
- 4. In medium bowl, combine flour, soda, salt, and baking powder. Add dry ingredients to pumpkin mixture and blend just until all ingredients are mixed. Divide batter between prepared pans.
- 5. Bake in preheated oven until toothpick comes out clean, about 1 hour.


