


PRESIDENTS REPORT

59th Season Gala Opening November 15th





Italian Horn Cookies

Wonderfully flavorful and fragrant bread for the holidays.

Prep Time: approx. 1530Minutes. Cook Time: approx. 10 Minutes. Makes: 5 Dozen

- · 1 cup cold butter, cubed
- · 4 cups all-purpose flour
- · 2 cups vanilla ice cream, softened
- 1 can (12 ounces) cherry jam and or pastry filling
- Sugar
- · Confectioners' sugar, optional

Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, cut butter into flour until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Stir in ice cream. Divide into 4 portions. Cover and refrigerate for 2 hours.
- Preheat oven to 350°. On a lightly floured surface, roll each portion to 1/8-in. thickness. With a pastry cutter, cut into 2-in. squares. Place about 1/2 teaspoon filling in the center of each square. Overlap 2 opposite corners of dough over the filling and seal. Sprinkle lightly with sugar.
- 3. Place on ungreased baking sheets. Bake until bottoms are light brown, 10-12 minutes. Cool on wire racks. If desired, dust with confectioners' sugar before serving.

This recipe is easy to make. If you think the squares are too small, just make them a little bit larger. You can use any jam you like.


