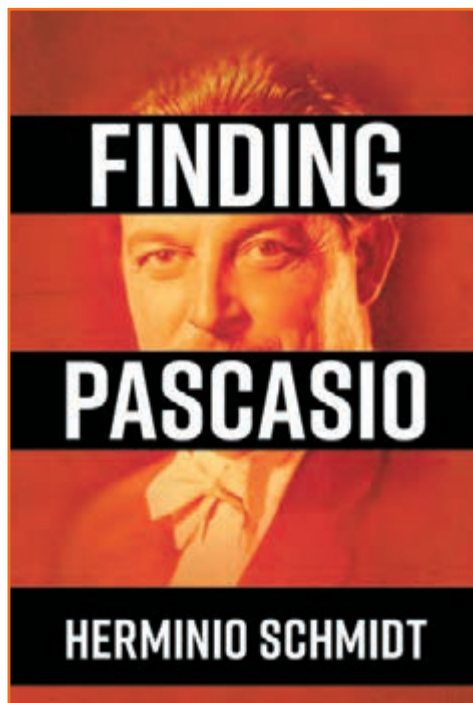

We feel that with only 50 people being allowed in a confined space we can not show the proper appreciation to the members that have been integral parts of our community for a decade or more. This years recipients will receive their awards at a time that has yet to be determined.

On the Labour Day weekend we also had a dozen potential campers register for a trial weekend of camping at our campground. In looking at early responses it looks like this will pay off with some new members joining us for the rest of this season as well as seasons moving forward.

In a ground breaking development we held the first Zoom semi annual meeting. After overcoming some technical difficulties we had about 40 members join us for the meeting. The German community has also been affected by the Coronavirus and this year we will not celebrate German Pioneers Day and Volkstrauertag by keeping the health and wellness of our members as an item of utmost importance.

I would like to say thank you to all the staff that have come to work and provided exceptional customer service and high quality food for our members and patrons to consume. I would also like to thank the members of this club who have either frequented the restaurant or patio or used the curb side pick up option to enjoy our fine German cuisine. Your support for the club at this time is greatly appreciated.

Until we can meet again (and I hope that this is sooner rather than later) I ask you all to stay safe, stay healthy and stay at home when needed.
