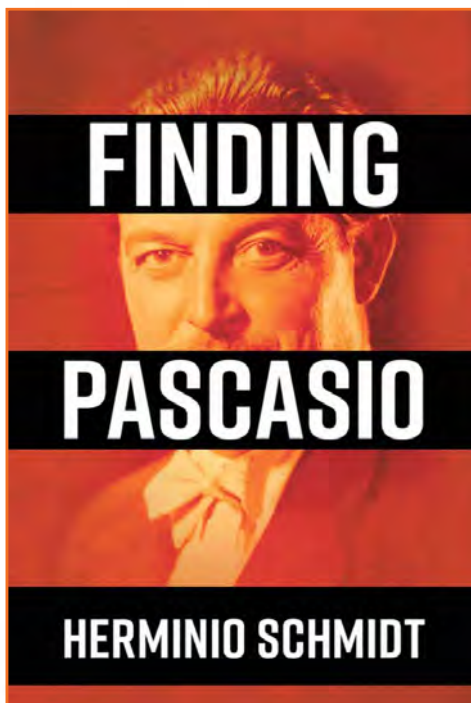

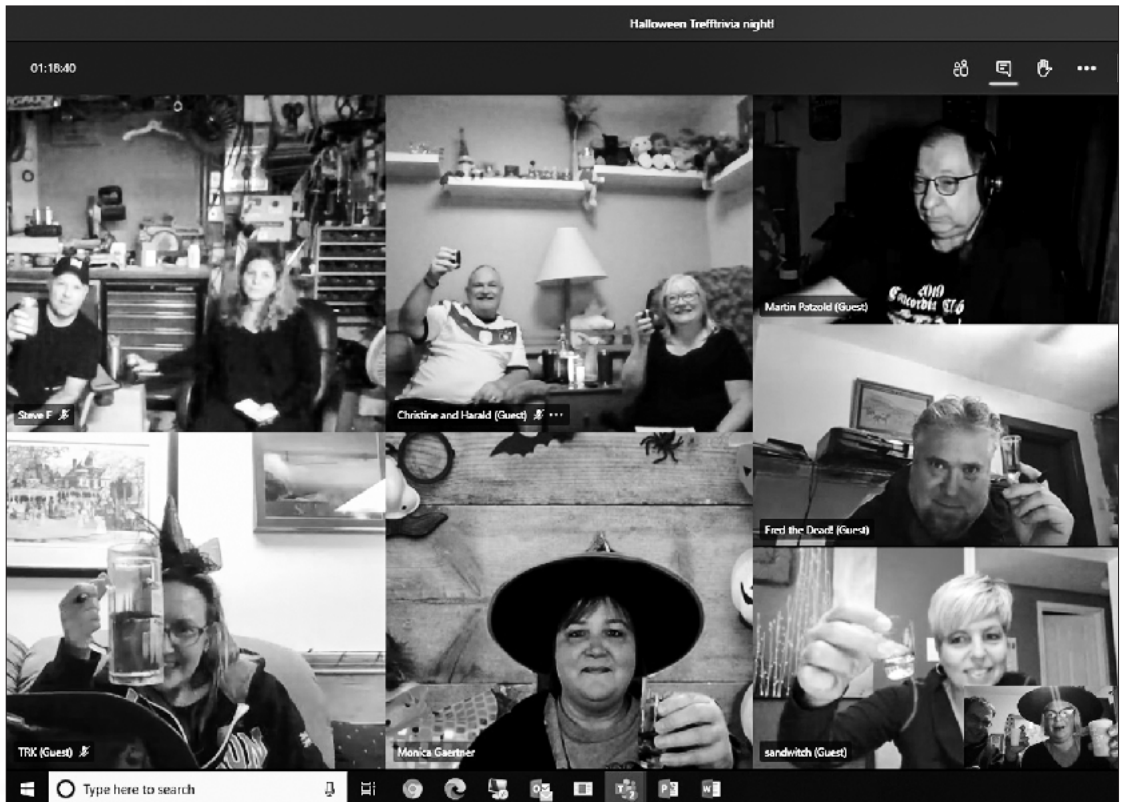

3. Put on the Christmas music and let it surround your home.
4. Bake a few different cookies each week.
5. Enjoy some of the cookies with a cup of coffee, tea or spirits, sit & relax.
6. Last of all enjoy a Christmas movie.

I do hope that this will cheer you up. If all else fails call a friend and tell them everything that you have done during the week.

CINNAMON ROLL COOKIES - HAPPY BAKING

Cinnamon and sugar make these cookies smell like everyone's favourite holiday breakfast. For best results, drizzle with glaze shortly before serving. Makes about 60 cookies.

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup (175 mL) butter, softened
- 1 cup (250 mL) packed brown sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp (5 mL) vanilla
- 2-1/2 cups (625 mL) all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp (5 mL) cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp (2 mL) baking powder
- 1 pinch salt

Cinnamon Sugar:

- 2 tbsp (30 mL) packed brown sugar
- 2 tbsp (30 mL) butter, softened
- 1 tsp (5 mL) cinnamon

Cream Cheese Glaze:

- 1/4 pkg (250 g pkg) cream cheese, softened
- 1/3 cup (75 mL) icing sugar
- 2 tbsp (30 mL) milk, warmed

Preparation

In large bowl, beat butter with sugar until fluffy; beat in egg and vanilla. Whisk together flour, cinnamon, baking powder and salt; stir into butter mixture in 3 additions.

Divide dough in half; shape into discs. Wrap each in plastic wrap; refrigerate for 1 hour. (Make-ahead: Refrigerate for up to 24 hours.) Let stand at room temperature until soft enough to roll out, about 15 minutes.

Between waxed paper or on floured surface, roll out 1 disc of dough to 12x10-inch (30 x 25 cm) rectangle.

Cinnamon Sugar: Combine sugar, butter and cinnamon; spread half evenly onto rectangle. Starting at long side, roll up dough. Wrap in plastic wrap and refrigerate until firm, about 30 minutes. Repeat with remaining dough and filling.

Cut rolls into 1/4-inch (5 mm) thick slices; place, cut side down and 1 inch (2.5 cm) apart, on parchment paper-lined or greased baking sheets.

Bake, 1 sheet at a time, in 375°F (190°C) oven until pale golden on bottoms and edges, about 10 minutes. Let cool for 1 minute on pans on racks; transfer to racks and let cool completely. (Make-ahead: Store in airtight container for up to 5 days or freeze for up to 2 weeks.)

Cream Cheese Glaze: Combine cream cheese, icing sugar and milk; drizzle over cooled cookies.

In December we have two gals celebrating birthdays. Best wishes to Ursula Dressler, and Erika Koeckritz, enjoy your special day.

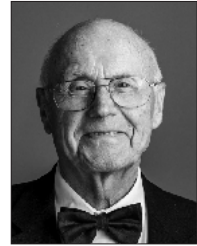
