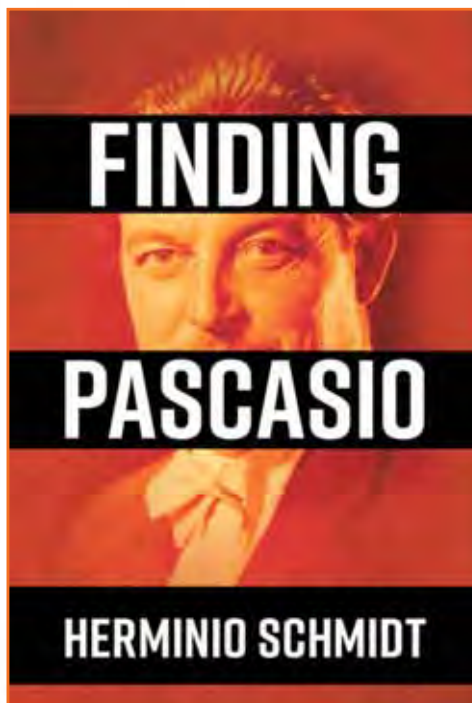

Well, this month we can look forward to March 20, the 1st day of spring. Hopefully we will be allowed to see our children by Easter and if it is warm enough we can always celebrate it outside.

There isn't much to report, but I am asking you all to stay safe, wash your hands often and wear a face mask when needed.

The Zwiebel Kuchen recipe below has been in my family for 4 generations. I hope you enjoy it. It is easy to make.

### Zwiebel Kuchen / Onion Cake

#### Dough - Warm oven to 350 F

2½ c. to 3 c. flour - 1 tbsp. yeast - about 1 ½ c. milk - 1 tsp. salt - 3-4 Spanish onions - Butter for sautéing onions - 1 lb. Sour cream. 2 eggs - mix into sour cream - add a little salt - Bacon

1. In a large warm bowl, dissolve yeast in lukewarm scalded milk. This takes about 10 minutes. Add salt to flour. Add yeast mixture to flour and mix until smooth.
2. Let rise until double the size.
3. While the dough is rising, cut onions and sauté in butter until el dente. Cool onions.
4. Beat eggs, then add sour cream and salt. Mix together.
5. Punch down the dough when finished rising and smooth out dough onto a greased baking sheet.
6. Spread cooled onions evenly on dough. Pour the sour cream mixture over the onions.
7. Chop bacon and divide evenly on top of mixture.
8. Bake at 350 F. until top starts to get colour.
