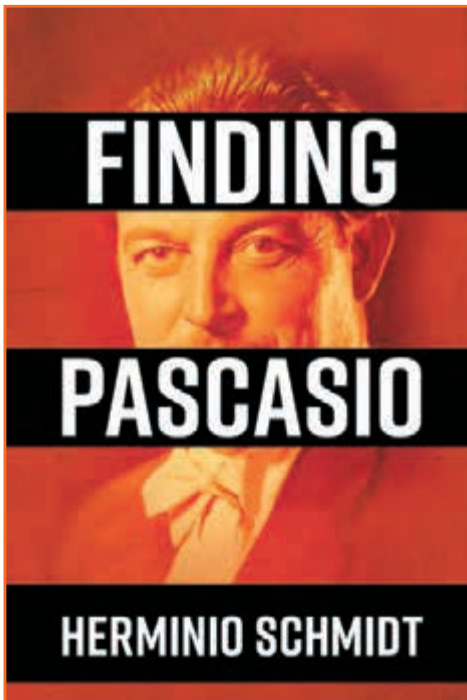

### Simple Rhubarb Cake

- 200 gr. sugar
- 200 gr. butter and margarine together (semi-soft)
- 1 tsp. vanilla or 2 pkg. of vanilla zucker
- 2 lg. eggs at room temperature
- 500 gr. flour (about 2 cups)
- 28 gr. of baking powder (5 level tsp)
- About 4 cups of cubed rhubarb
- Pre-heat oven to 350 F.
- Mix all ingredients together with your hands.
- Put about ¾ of the dough into a rectangular greased baking pan and spread out flat with the tips of your fingers.
- Sprinkle dough with rhubarb.
- Crumble the remaining dough over the rhubarb.
- Bake for about 45 minutes.

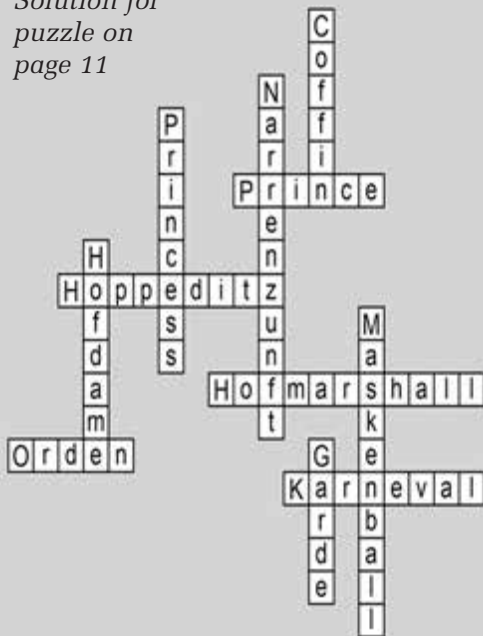
