Light Asparagus & Chicken Salad

1 pound	Asparagus cut into 1 in. or 2.5 cm pieces	500 g
2	hard-cooked eggs, chopped	2
2 cups	diced cooked chicken (2 lg. chicken breasts)	500 ml
½ cups	sliced radishes (6 medium)	125 ml
¼ cup	vegetable oil	50 ml
1 tbsp	lemon juice	15 ml
1 tbsp	mayonnaise	15 ml
½ tsp	salt	2.5 ml
¼ tsp	dried tarragon leaves, crushed	1 ml

Directions:

Steam asparagus until tender-crisp. Drain and run under cold water to chill. Pat dry. In salad bowl, combine asparagus, eggs, chicken and radishes.

Cover and chill.

In a small bowl, whisk together remaining ingredients until smooth.

Cover and chill.

Just before serving, pour dressing over salad and toss gently.

Makes 4 servings.

Well April showers have brought beautiful May flowers. For all of our Concordia Mothers past and present, we celebrate you. Not only on Mother's Day but every day.

HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

We held our second on-line choir night and we actually were able to do some singing thanks to our conductor Martin and his lovely wife Stella. We look forward to more evenings like this. By now many of you have had your first vaccine and are looking forward to a future with more normalized activities. Masks may become an important part in our ability to come together as a choir in the near future. Dr. Kym Scott, School of Music, University of West Virginia has developed what she terms a performance mask, that allows choir members to sing without the muffling effects of the standard mask. Scott's masks have a cupped shape that holds the fabric about 10 centimeters away from the nose and mouth, but the rest

needs to fit very snugly to avoid having any of the pockets of air that aerosol particles are coming in and out of. The masks were tested through the Centre for Inhalation Toxicology and her masks scored much better than standard masks for preventing droplets from getting in or out.

Choral singing has been hard hit by the pandemic because it is based inherently on gathering and being close to sing in harmony with one another. With many outbreaks tied to choral singing it's impossible to know if transmissions were linked to singing alone, or the fact that singers were in close proximity to each other, perhaps hugging as they greeted each other, sharing sheet music, etc. Using experts in computational fluid dynamics, optical imaging and infectious disease researchers are now studying what actually happens with droplets when people sing. How far they travel the front side and what difference it makes when people sing low, high, loud or soft.

In the meantime, research from other parts of the world is making a strong case for singing while masked. Some studies have shown that singing with a mask removes most of the problems.

The Ontario Music Education Association has put out a recommendation for a safe return to singing during the pandemic must include wearing a mask, standing at least 3 meters apart, facing forward, and no shared music. We will continue to keep you up to date as more information becomes available.
