Mother Nature must have a touch of Covid 19 as we have been blessed with some very unpredictable weather this summer. Due to the longevity of the Coronavirus having been here and the uncertainty of the new strains and their effects we do not have any events planned for the remainder of this year. The board is always discussing the possibilities and has plans in place to have the events but we need to be mindful of the health and safety of our members and the staff. If there are any changes we will communicate this through our social media channels and the bulletin.

The farm has been able to welcome even more new campers. They have had a successful fishing derby and socially distanced bingo day. The spirit of many of the new campers has enabled us to do even more cleanup than last year and I can tell you that this is the best that the farm has ever looked. Thank you to all of the members that have helped to polish this gem back to a gleaming diamond.

Ladies Group

Summer is almost over and hopefully we will still have lots of nice weather. We have not seen most of our ladies since last year at our picnic, so once again on August 18; we will have our annual Ladies Group picnic. I would like to remind everyone that the club restaurant is open and it would be nice to support our club. All the tables are nicely spaced so that you are seated far from anyone else.

The recipe below is one that I make all the time. It can be prepared the day before if be needed so you just have to put it in the pan when ready to use. It is one of mine and may husband's favourites.

ROSEMARY AND GARLIC GRILLED PORK LOIN

It's easy to make last minute but elegant enough for a special occasion.

Ingredients

- 1 tbsp Olive oil
- 3 cloves medium finely chopped garlic
- 2 tbsp Rosemary
- ½ tsp table salt
- 1 pinch black pepper

1 whole loin uncooked lean pork tenderloin

Instructions

1. Prepare grill for medium-hot, indirect cooking, or preheat oven to 425°F.
2. Mix together oil, garlic, rosemary, salt and pepper, crushing rosemary slightly with a spoon as you mix. Spread mixture over pork, covering entire surface. Wrap the loin tightly in plastic wrap and refrigerate for at least one hour (up to overnight).
3. Remove plastic wrap and place pork on grill. Grill outdoors over indirect heat, turning occasionally, until a meat thermometer measures an internal temperature of 155-160°F, about 25 minutes. Or, indoors, place tenderloin in a shallow roasting pan and roast until internal temperature measured with a meat thermometer reads 155-160°F, about 20 minutes.

(Note: Pork loin can be pink and juicy inside and be fully cooked, but it is important that the temperature be no less than 160°F.)
4. Remove pork from grill or oven and let rest for 10 minutes before slicing.
